THE WINE


Lodi's historic old-vine Zinfandel sites contribute the largest portion of this blend, along with fruit from Paso Robles, Amador County, and San Luis Obispo. Warm afternoons in Lodi enhance the berry flavors while fruit from the cooler coastal regions bring softer characteristics and balance. In the bold tradition of 1000 Stories, Batch 91 was aged in French and American oak barrels, then finished in aged bourbon barrels. Our Zinfandel Batch 91 is light to medium bodied with a silky texture and long finish. The layered flavors of Zinfandel coupled with our bold barrel ageing method result in notes of cranberries, dark cherries, currants, cinnamon, vanilla beans, toffee and dried herbs.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Aged in American and French Oak, then finished off in bourbon barrels
Pair with BBQ pulled pork sandwich or BBQ ribs

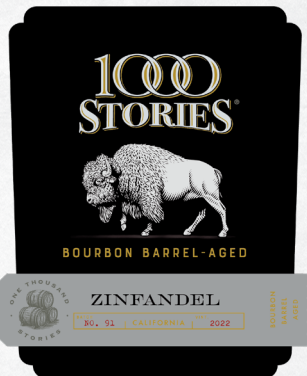
